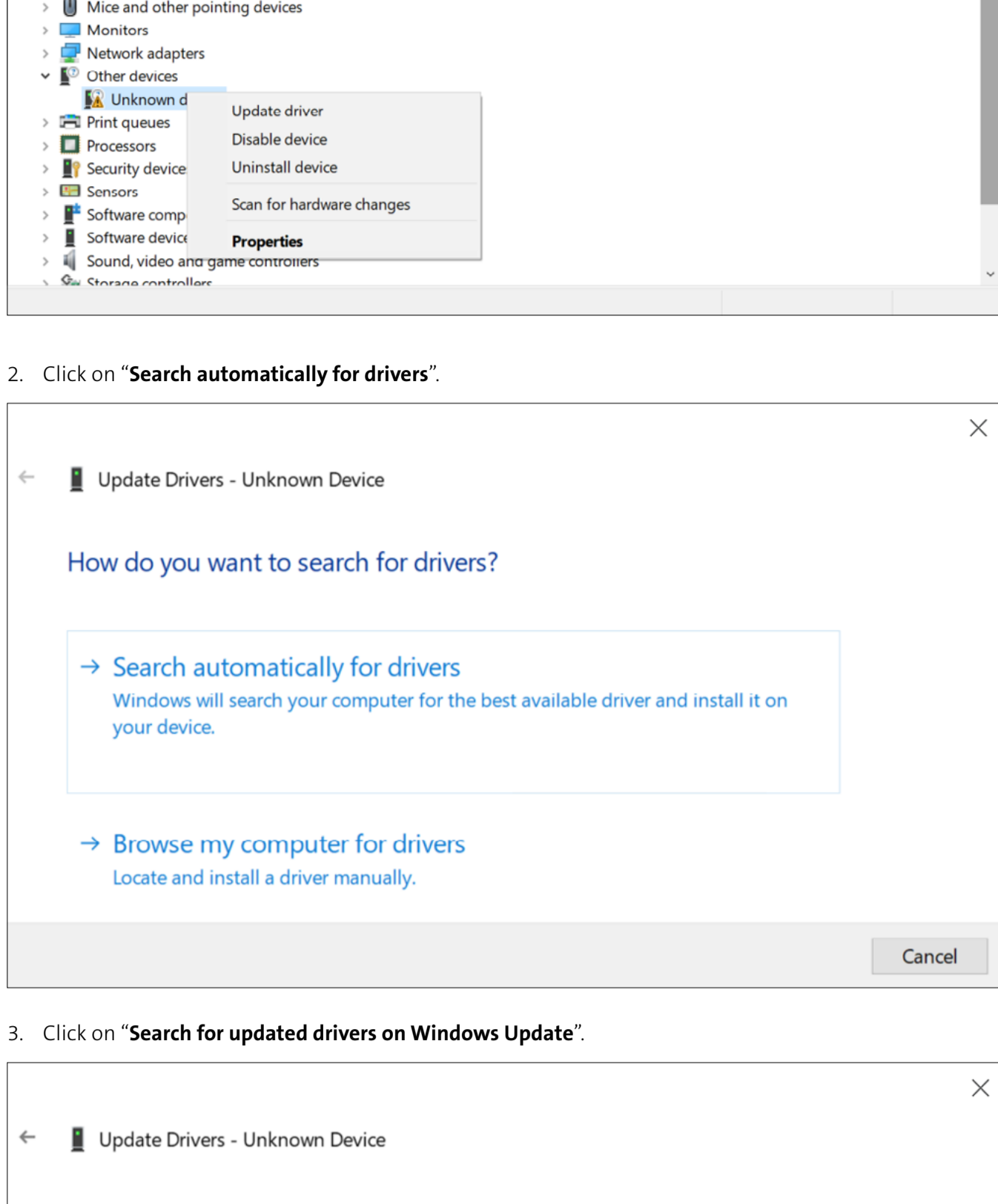


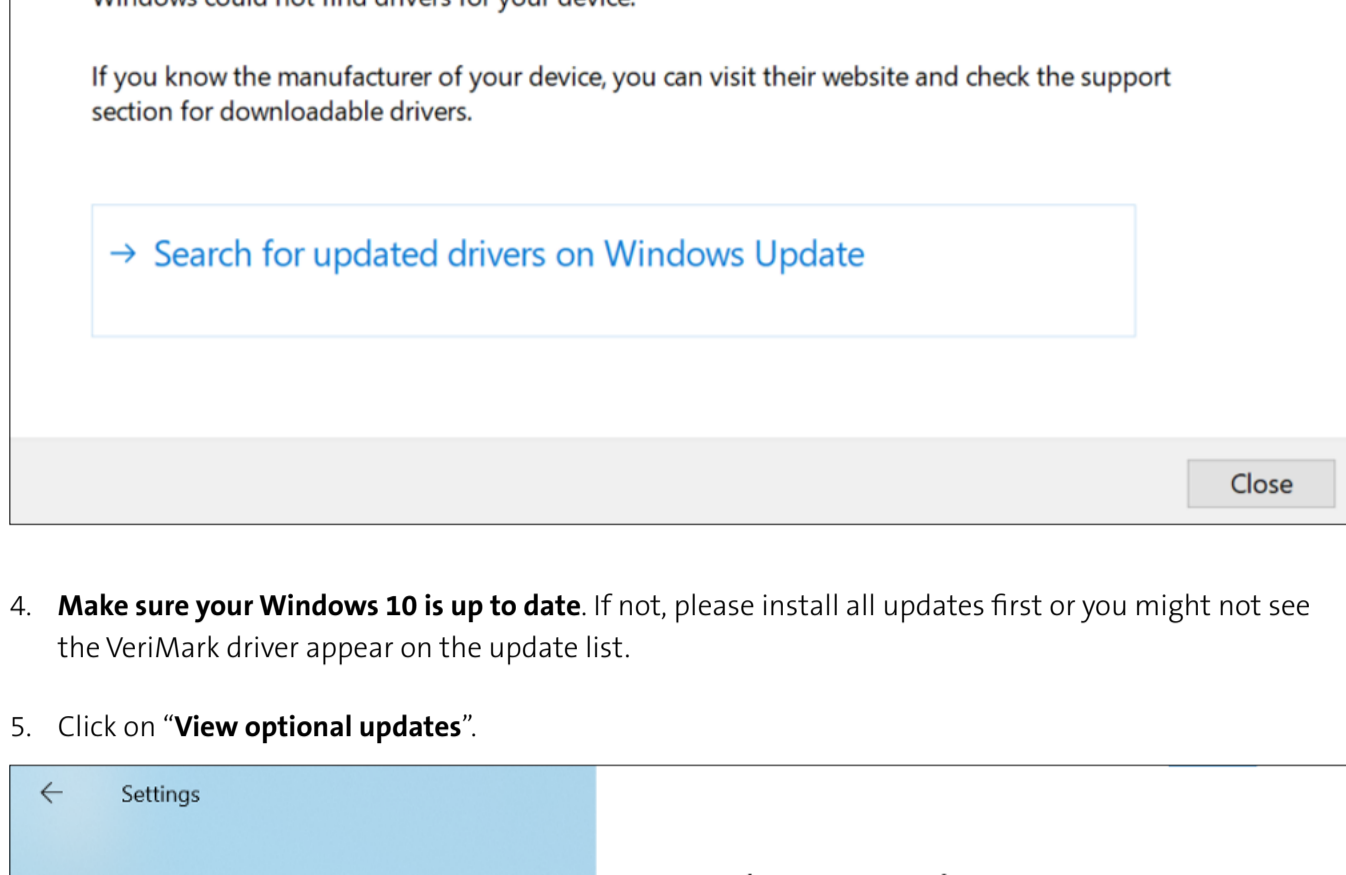
VeriMark Windows 10 Optional Driver Install

Install the driver through Windows 10 Optional Windows Update

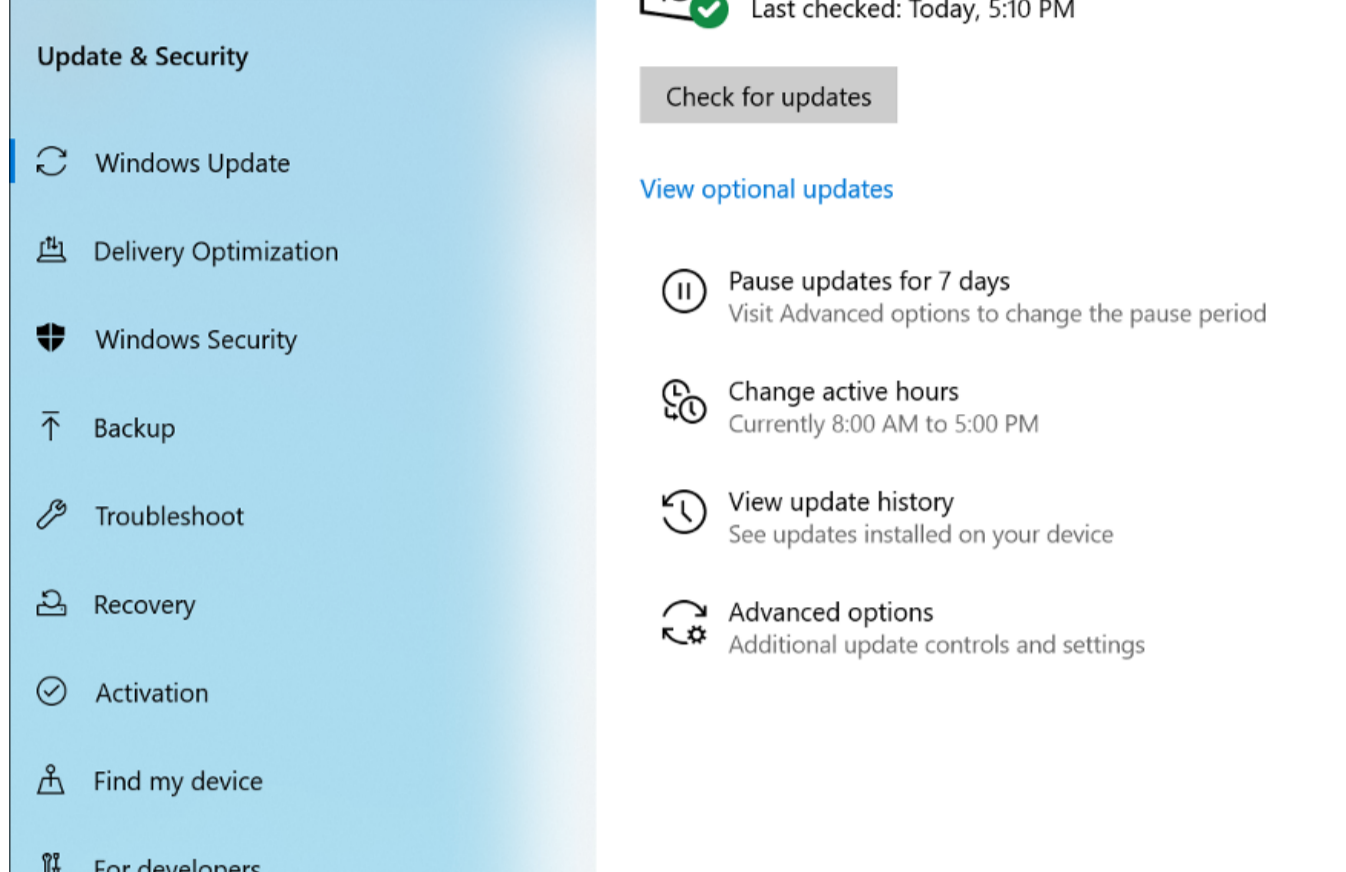
1. Go to **Device Manager** and right click on the unknown device and select **Update driver**.



2. Click on **"Search automatically for drivers"**.

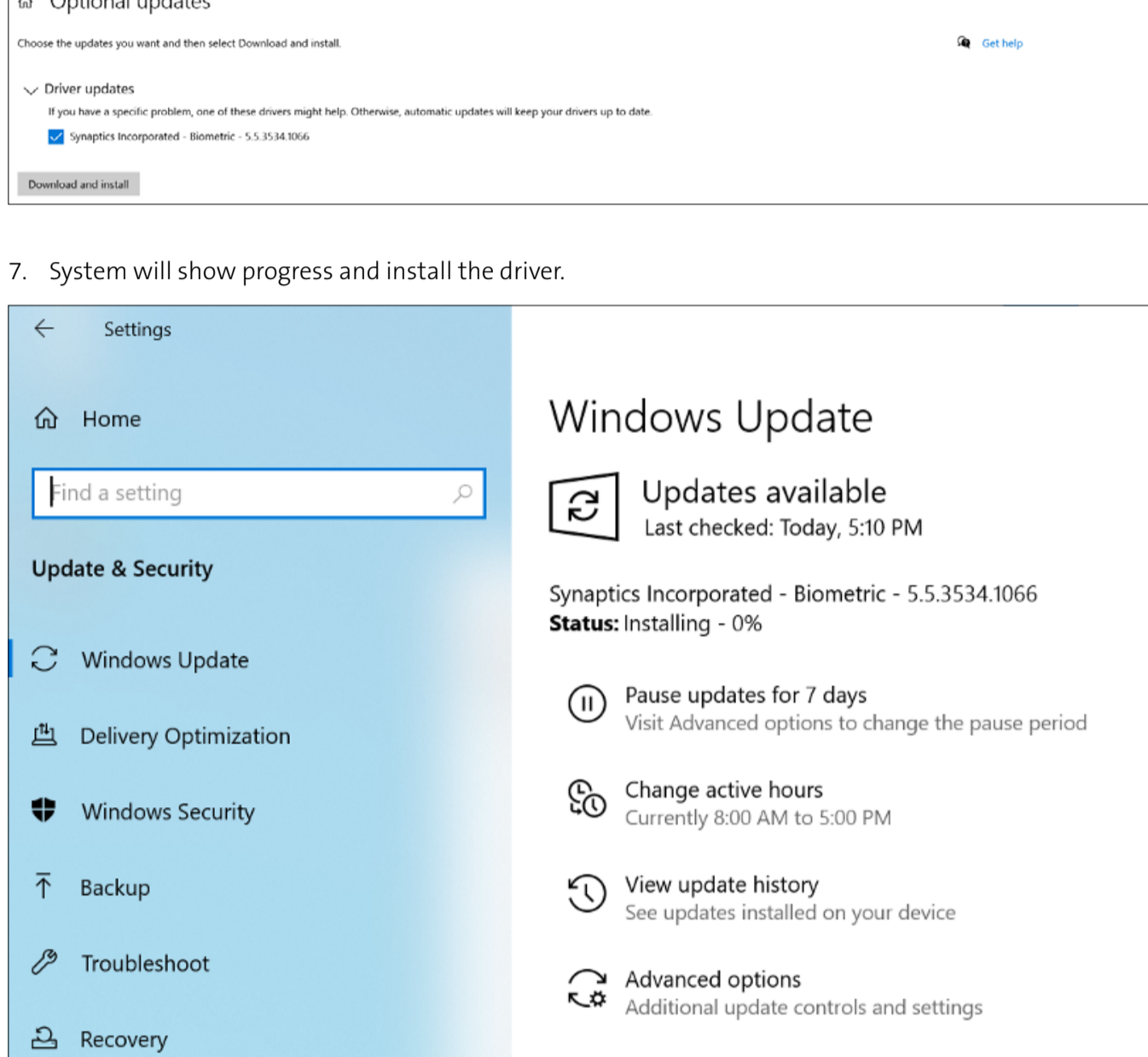


3. Click on **"Search for updated drivers on Windows Update"**.

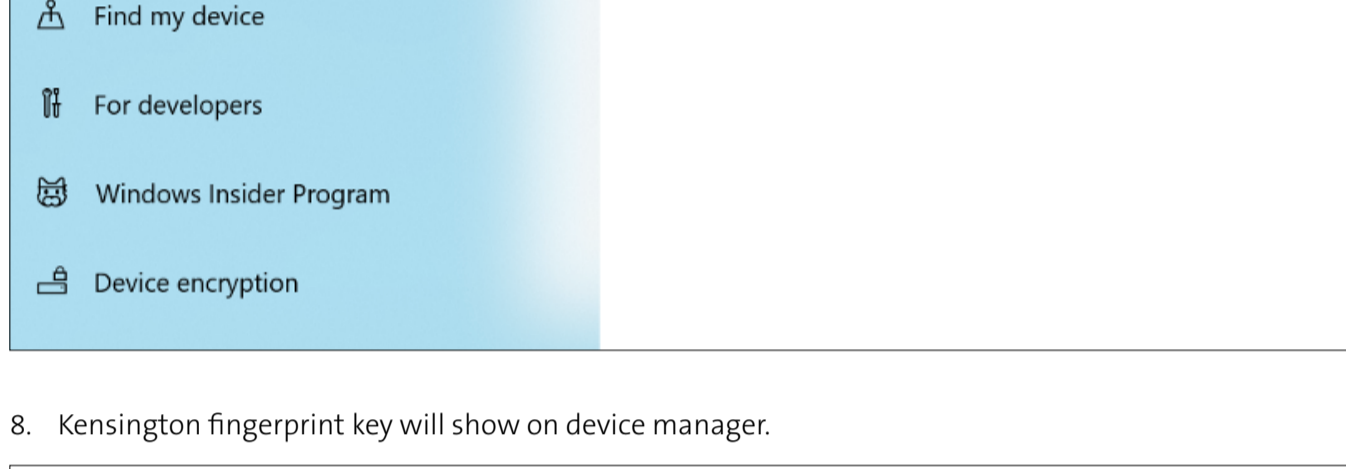


4. **Make sure your Windows 10 is up to date.** If not, please install all updates first or you might not see the VeriMark driver appear on the update list.

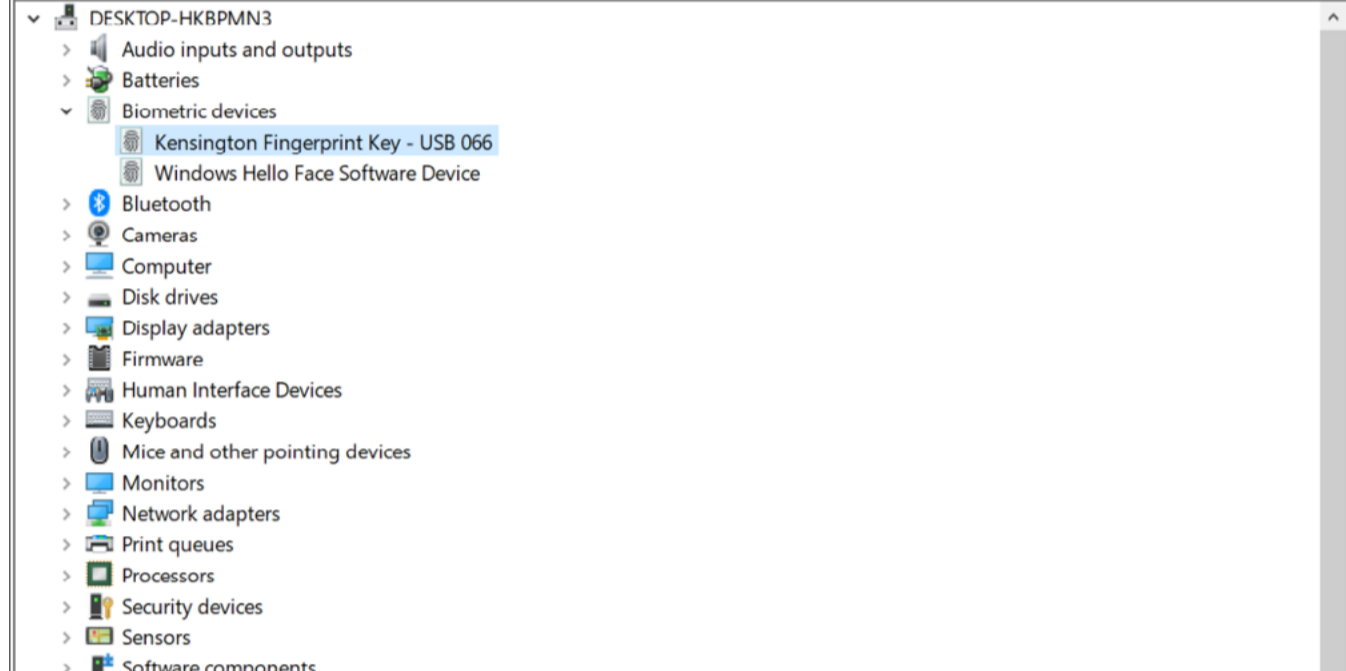
5. Click on **"View optional updates"**.



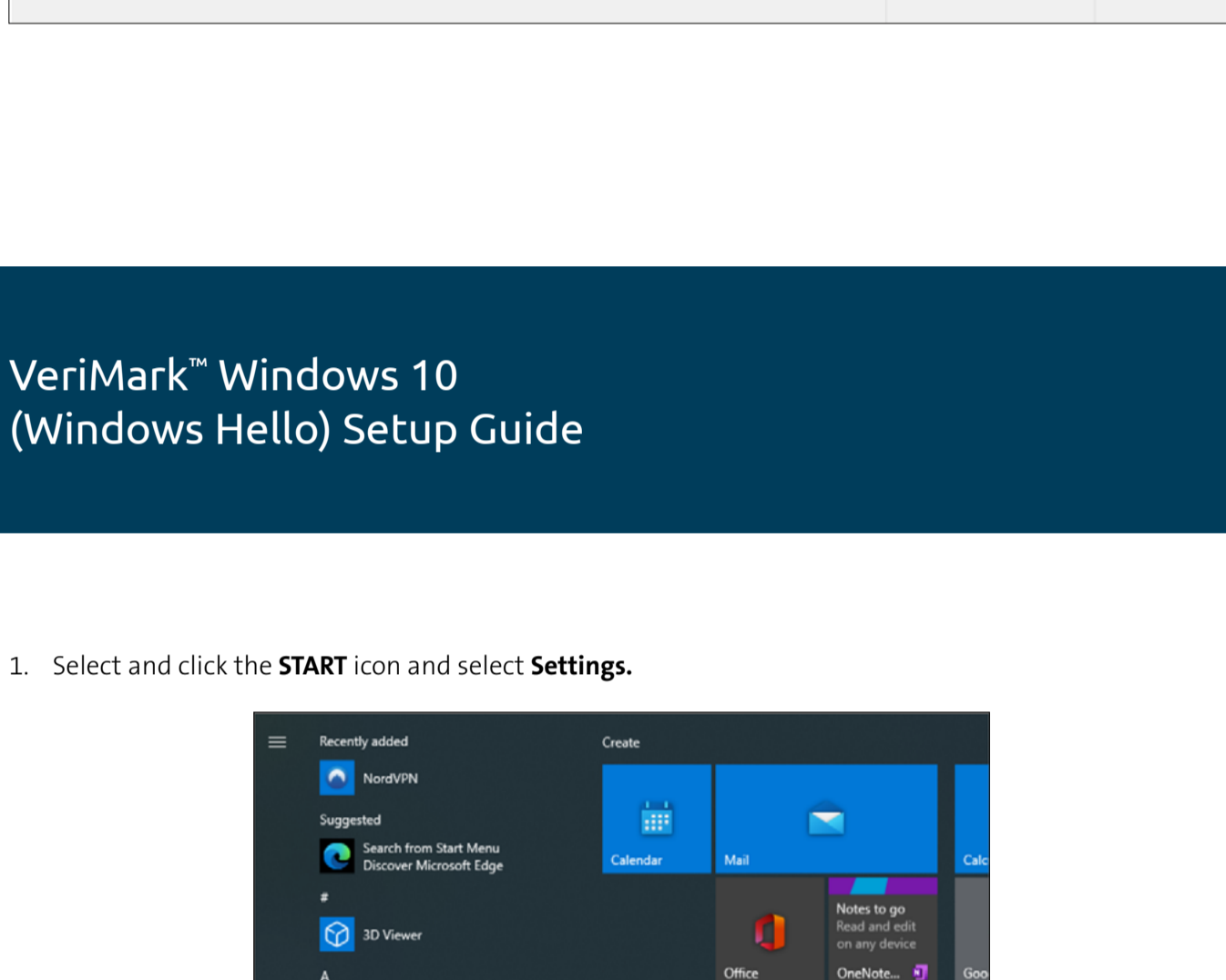
6. Select **"Synaptics Incorporated – Biometric"**, and click on the button **Download and install**.



7. System will show progress and install the driver.

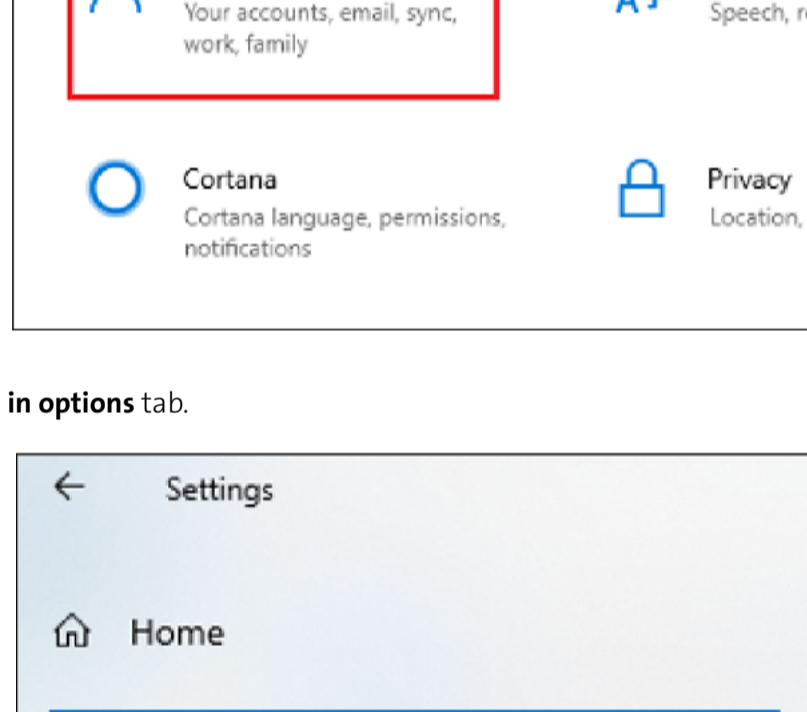


8. Kensington fingerprint key will show on device manager.

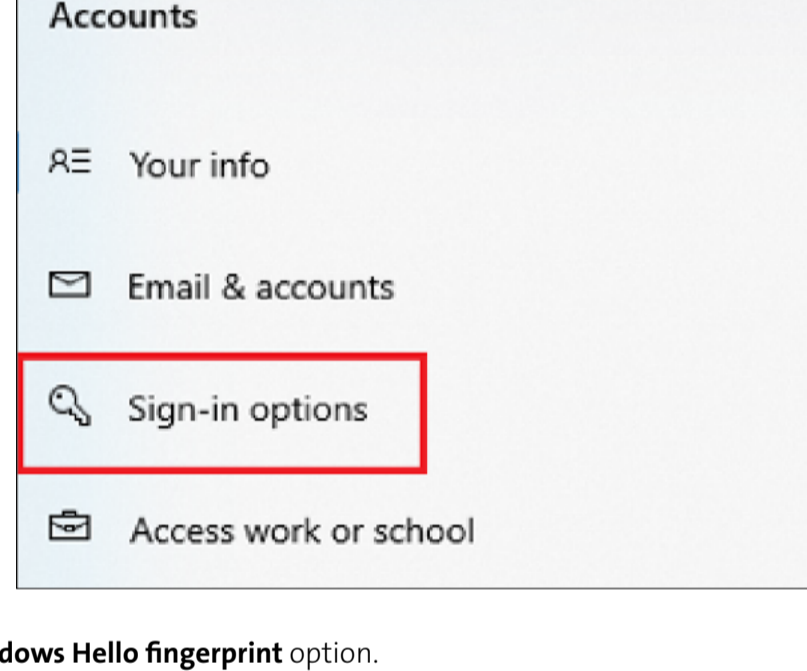


VeriMark™ Windows 10 (Windows Hello) Setup Guide

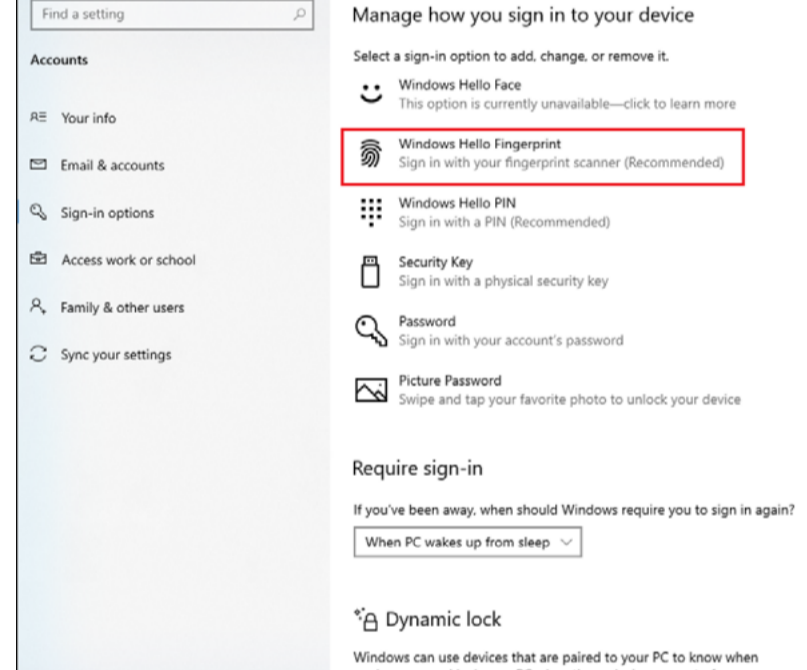
1. Select and click the **START** icon and select **Settings**.



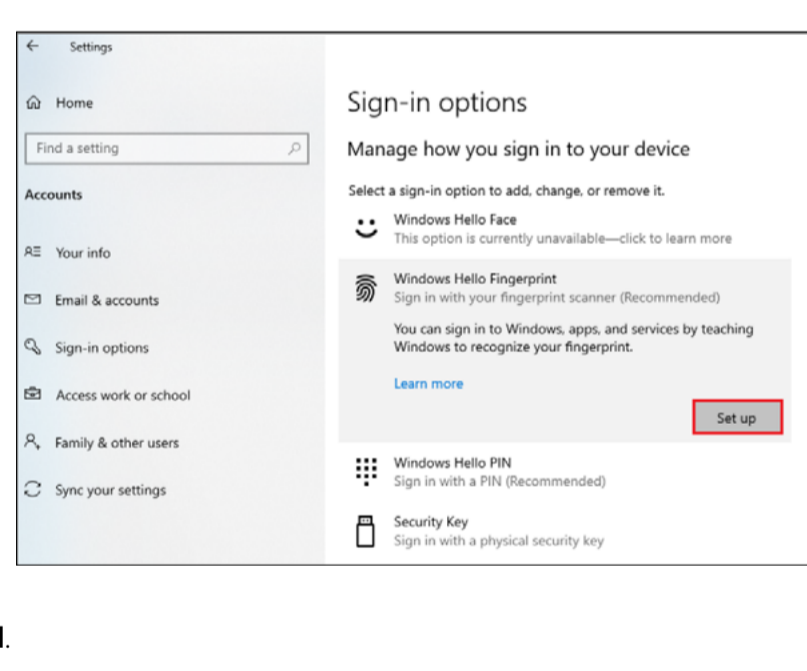
2. Select **Accounts**.



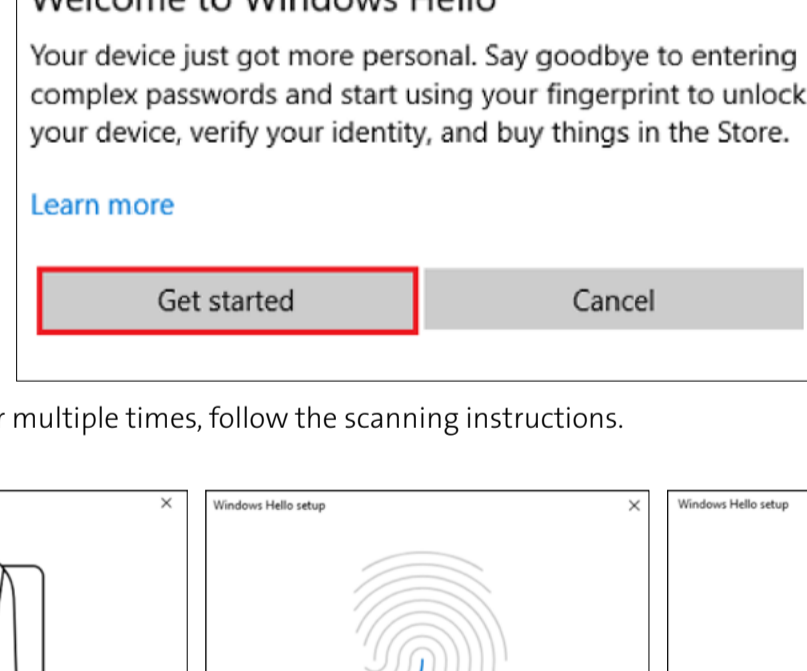
3. Click on the **Sign in options** tab.



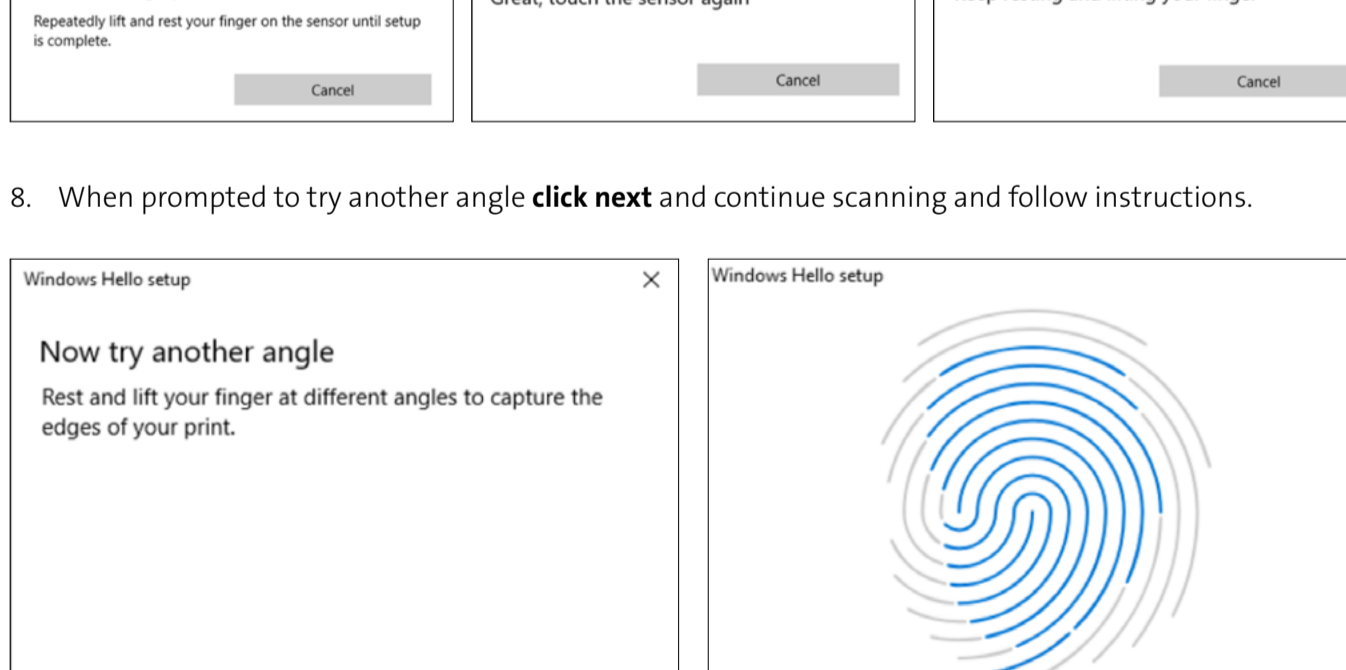
4. Click on the **Windows Hello fingerprint** option.



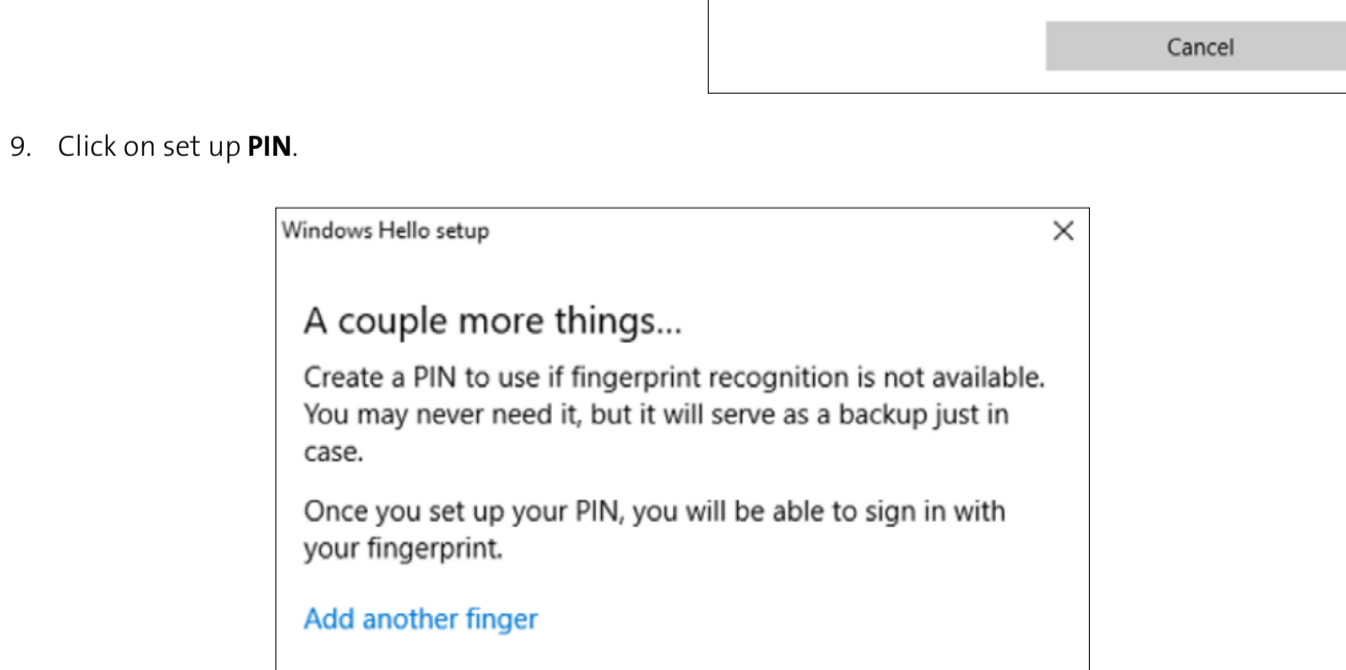
5. Then click **Set up** button.



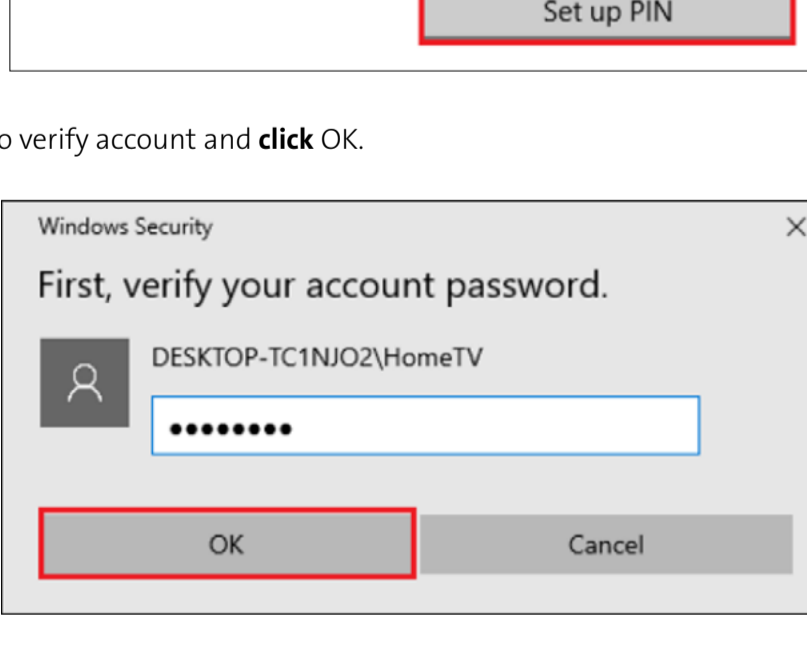
7. Touch the sensor multiple times, follow the scanning instructions.



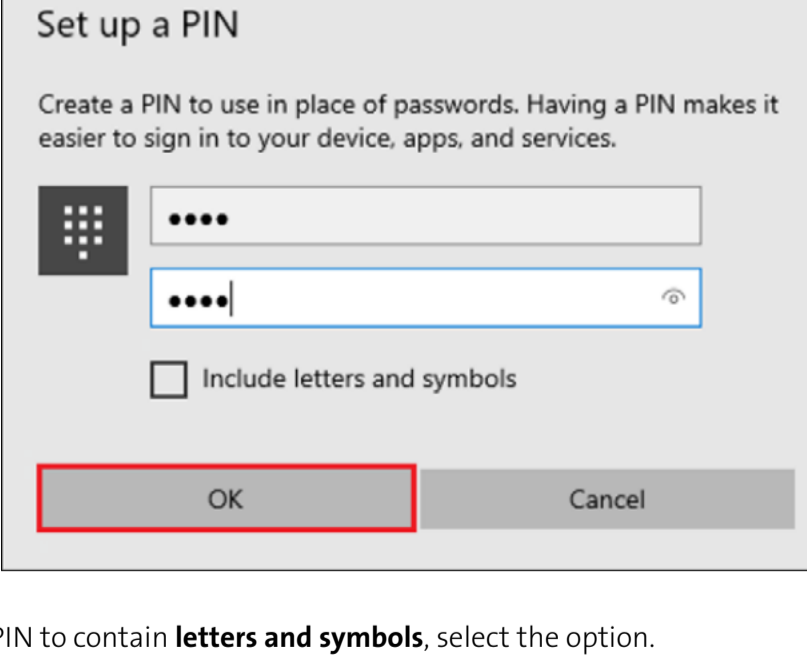
8. When prompted to try another angle **click next** and continue scanning and follow instructions.



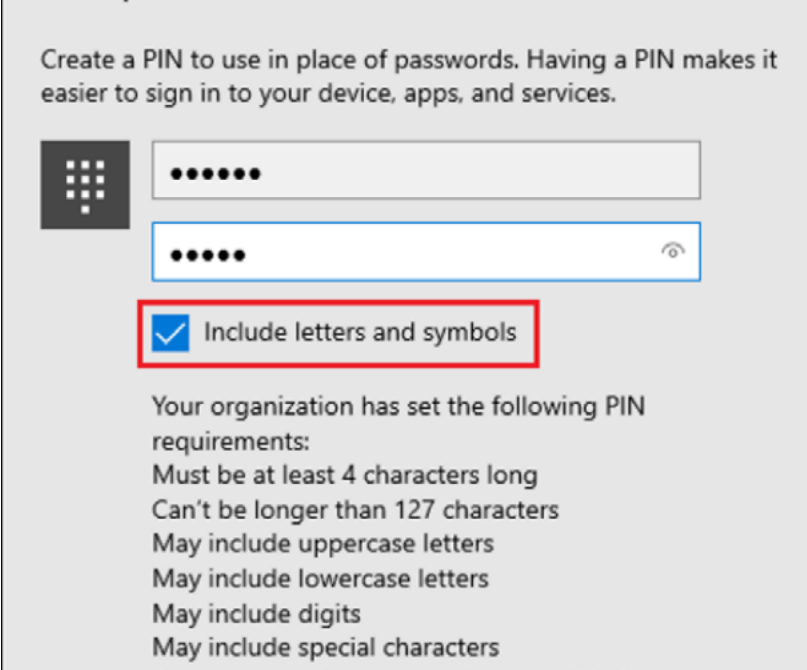
9. Click on **set up PIN**.



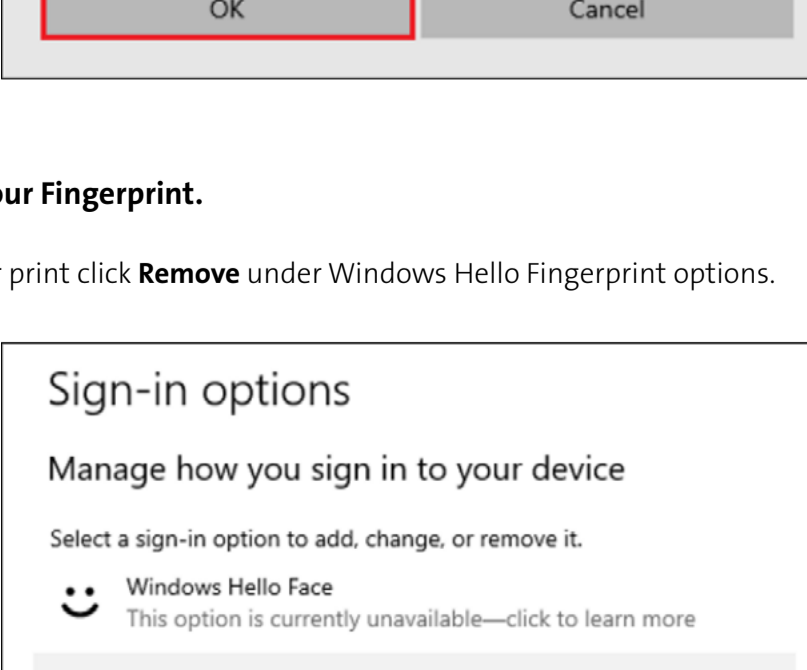
10. **Type** password to verify account and **click** OK.
